GENERAL CONVENTIONS FOR 1903.

Three General Conventions are proposed for this year. The first, in Atlanta, Ga., April 4 and 5; the second at Denver, Colo., about July 1st; the third at Toronto, Canada, about September 1st. (Definite dates for the last two will be announced later. We make the general announcement so long in advance that the friends may make their arrangements accordingly.)

GENERAL CONVENTION AT ATLANTA, GA.

As announced in our last issue, this General Convention will take place on April 4 and 5. Atlanta friends are sparing no pains to make the meetings profitable. Bro. Russell will be present, besides other capable brethren, and provision will be made for symbolic baptism, in water. The public meeting will be held in the Grand Opera House on Sunday afternoon at 3 o'clock. All other meetings will be in Knights of Pythias Hall, cor. Pryor and Hunter Sts.

The condition of the special rate granted by the railroads in the South-Eastern Passenger Association is that purchasers of tickets shall pay full fare one way, and when buying ticket "procure from agent a Convention Certificate." On no account overlook this, as the Certificate entitles the holder to reduction of return fare to one-third, plus 25 cents. This rate is good for return within three days after the 5th. Notify R.R. Agent at once that you may want such a certificate.

Arrangements will be made for sleeping accommodations at 50c and \$1 per day, and meals at reasonable rates can be secured within easy reach of the meeting places. Those who desire to attend, and who cannot afford to pay for accommodation will be provided for free.

Those contemplating attendance should write at once to us, stating the number and sex of the party purposing to go, and which class of accommodation is desired.
